Marching Band

Summer Band begins late July or August 1


- 7:00 AM 10:00 AM on marching days prior to August 1

1. The marching band practices on most weeks 7 ½ hours a week.

Friday - Football Game

- 2. A "Primary" spot is one that is in our contest show. A "Game Day" spot is one that performs at every football game, but is not part of our contest production. Prop spots are considered a "Primary" spot.
- 3. Every student marches at football games.
- 4. Students who are in other PHS school activities (i.e. football, volleyball) participate with the marching band unless their sport is in season during the fall semester. These students are expected to participate in practice when their sport is not practicing.

Band Physicals

The UIL has just passed a new requirement for students involved in marching band activities.

All participating students are required to have a physical on file. Physicals must be done after May 1 or on the designated school district date.

PISD will require band students to have a physical done every year in order to participate in marching band activities.

This is a new state requirement.

Energy Drinks and Band

Energy drinks are very popular with the students; however, they can have some adverse effects.

- Increased caffeine raises the heart rate.
- High sugar content can lead to faster dehydration.
- These two factors can lead to faster onset of heat related illness!

Please encourage your child to drink lots of WATER!!

Turner HS and the PHS Band

Students enrolled at Turner HS may participate in activities at PHS.

Turner students are limited to 1st Period (Cadet Band) or 6th Period (Symphonic Band)

Students must earn placement in the proper band any movement to accommodate the Turner HS schedule will be down.

(ex. Turner student auditions in the Concert Band, that student would be placed in Cadet Band)

Turner students are full participants in the Marching Band

Turner HS students can participate in the PHS Band. Please understand that this does limit Turner students to our 1st Period (Cadet Band, 4th Band) or 6th Period band classes (Symphonic Band, 2nd Band. Students must qualify for the band for placement. If a student is placed in a higher band from their audition, they will be placed in the lower band that accommodates their schedule.

We do have several students who choose to become full PHS students after one year at Turner HS.

Turner students who have 1st Period band ride the travel bus after 1st Period to Turner HS. Students who are in 6th Period take the travel bus at 12:10 PM from Turner HS to PHS. There is also a bus that brings Turner students to PHS for after school activities.

School Owned Instrument Check-out

- Will be issued at the end of this year after inventory
- In order to check-out an instrument
 - Parent must be present to sign Agreement
 - \$50 Usage Fee must be paid (PISD)
 - Please note some instruments might be out for repairs.
 - Contact Mr. Brown in May if you need assistance.

PISD instrument fee is \$50/semester.

Checks must have driver's license number, phone number, student name and student ID# visible on the check

Band Auditions

Auditions will be held in May.

- Each instrument will have a designated day after school.
- HS Students will audition at 2:45 PM and JH students will start at 4:30 PM.

Audition music will be distributed in April to the JH's. All students who audition qualify for the PHS Band.


Thank you for your attendance and we look forward to having your child join "The Pride of Pearland"!

The Pearland High School Band Booster Club uses CHARMS to communicate with parents and students, track student accounts, and coordinate volunteers for band concerts and fundraisers.


To Access CHARMS

Log on to www.charmsoffice.com and click the "ENTER" link at the upper right. Locate the "PARENT/STUDENT/ MEMBERS LOGIN" section.



Login to the Pearland High School Band account using the following school code:

PearlandHSBand



This will allow you to review public information, including the public calendar, relevant handouts and files, and a link to the Pride of Pearland Band Website.



To Access Individual Student Information


Login to an individual student's account by entering the student's Pearland HS ID number in the Student Area Password box/field. Click the blue Enter button and you will see the complete menu page for all Band Activities.



Once you have logged into the private portion of CHARMS with your child's unique school ID number, you can change the password, update your information, see your student's financial status, confirm that required forms have been submitted, sign up to volunteer for an event, etc. The student may also use the Recording Studio portion of the CHARMS site.

To Update Personal Information

You may make changes to your student information page, such as updating phone numbers and email addresses. This will make communication with you more effective. Select the Update Info icon to edit the student and parent contact information. Scroll down to see parent names and information. Be sure to click the green update button in the upper right corner to save changes.

They are totally separate accounts and what follows are basic guidelines for how to pay the various groups.


PHS BAND FEES

To pay band fees make payable to PHS Band. We accept checks, cash and credit cards. Band Fees (for example: Meal Fee, Uniform fee, water bottle, shoes, or show shirt) may be paid from miscellaneous ledger credit balance.

Withdrawal from students accounts are made only if it is requested by charms or by filling out a band envelope.

Instrument Usage Fees: make payable to PEARLAND ISD. Payment may not be paid from student account credit. The fee may be paid with a separate check or cash. <u>Please do not pay this online with a credit card.</u>

Accompanist Fee: payable to the Individual – check payable to accompanist or cash only.

Music & Arts: fee payable to Music and Arts

- Please do not combine payments to multiple groups or the check cannot be processed. In order to get funds deposited, please use a correct band envelope, filled out completely and put the envelope in the "Black Box" locate in the band hall.
